

Note: Private duty is one-on-one care provided to an individual in their home or other private setting, often by a registered nurse (RN) or licensed practical nurse (LPN). This care is typically more intensive and continuous than standard home health visits, and may involve a range of medical and non-medical tasks tailored to the patient's specific needs.

What is Physical Therapy?

Physical therapy is treatment provided by a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant that helps people improve their movement and physical function, manage pain and other chronic conditions, and recover from and prevent injury and chronic disease.



According to the American Physical Therapist Association, Therapists Are Movement Experts.

Physical therapists are licensed doctors who examine, diagnose, and treat movement dysfunction. They Help people impacted by disease, injury, and disability. Research shows physical therapy Prevent movement loss and promote wellness. They are able to achieve satisfactory results with the Use of therapeutic exercise, modalities, assistive devices, patient education, and evidence- based research to treat patients.

The responsibility includes Implementing components of patient care, obtain data related to the treatments provided, and collaborate with physical therapists to modify care, as necessary.


Physical therapist assistants are not the same as physical therapy aides.

A doctor may order in-home physical therapy for seniors who have had an injury, surgery or illness that makes it hard to do daily tasks. For example, in-home physical therapy may be prescribed for you by your doctor if you qualify for home health and you have the following:

- Surgery like a knee or hip replacement
- Recent heart attack
- Acute-onset medical condition
- Exacerbation of a chronic medical condition like heart failure, COPD or diabetes
- Trouble with balance or falls
- Difficulty walking or moving around
- Pain after an injury, surgery or illness
- Functional decline related to a progressive neurological condition such as Parkinson's,
 Multiple Sclerosis or ALS
- Suffered from a stroke and have loss of use of one or more extremities

In the May/June 2024 National Poll on Healthy Aging, researchers from the Institute of Healthcare Policy and Innovation at University of Michigan asked older Americans 50 and above about their top 10 health-related concerns.
